Bachelor's Degree Requirements

Effective July 1 2024 Approved March 2024

General

A double major is defined as completing the requirements of two different majors simultaneously, resulting in the awarding of one baccalaureate degree (i.e., a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree). A double major can only be earned in separate programs, and are subject to exclusions approved by departments. There is no limit to courses common to both majors.

If both majors are within a single bachelor's degree: either a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or a Bachelor of Science (BS) the student will receive one degree (BA or BS) and both majors will be listed on the diploma. The student's transcript will indicate they have fulfilled the course requirements for both majors.
